## FRIDAY, OCTOBER 26TH

10:00 am - 2:00 pm Fall and Christmas Basket Class with Claudia. Come make a basket decorated in fall colors or with Christmas Spirit! Learn the basics of Appalachian Basketry. Beginners welcome!
